

Simpson Thacher Represents Underwriters in \$2.25 Billion Senior Notes Offering by Northrop Grumman

Simpson Thacher represented the underwriters, led by J.P. Morgan Securities LLC, BofA Securities, Inc. and Citigroup Global Markets Inc., in connection with the registered public offering by Northrop Grumman Corporation (“Northrop Grumman”), of \$750 million aggregate principal amount of 4.4% Senior Notes due 2030, \$500 million aggregate principal amount of 5.15% Senior Notes due 2040 and \$1 billion aggregate principal amount of 5.25% Senior Notes due 2050. Northrop Grumman intends to use the net proceeds of the offering for general corporate purposes.
